Thank you to Estelle for working so hard to get a freezer donated to the Fire Department from Home Depot. The Firefighters truly do appreciate it.


CAL TRANS

YERMO CHECK


During the last meeting it was stated that there were some questions from Director Tolbert about a check written to the Yermo Fire Department.
