


CAL FIRE - Office of the State Fire Marshal Information Bulletin 21-002

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Kidde Recalls TruSense Smoke and Combination Smoke/Carbon Monoxide Alarm (Model Series 2040, 2050, 2060, and 2070)



On May 6, 2021, fire safety products manufacturer Kidde recalled Model Series 2040, 2050, 2060, and 2070 Smoke and Combination Smoke/Carbon Monoxide Alarms due to risk of failure to alert consumers to a fire.

Only alarms with the TruSense logo or "AMBER=FAULT" printed on the front of the alarm are included in this recall. The model number is printed on the back of the alarm.

The recalled units are the following:

Consumers should immediately contact Kidde for a free replacement alarm. Consumers should keep using the recalled alarms until they install replacement alarms.
